Computer Graphics: 'The Future'

Original work based on the theme 'The Future', created on the computer and printed on paper. *(This could be done using J2e, or a suitable drawing app)*

Computer Design

Design a gig poster for a Welsh band or music artist. You can choose to present the poster in Welsh-only, or bilingually. *The finished work should be printed on A4 paper. (This could be done using PowerPoint, PicCollage or a suitable graphics programme)*

Scratch Project

Create a project in Scratch based on the theme 'The Future'. This will be judged based on the 'script' you have created, and the actions the project is able to perform. You must be able to show the project in school (to Mr Fisher) on March 2nd. This means it should be saved to your Scratch projects on your account.

Photography

Every item should be mounted on black card no more than 600mm x 500mm.

One print based on the theme 'A Welsh Future'
